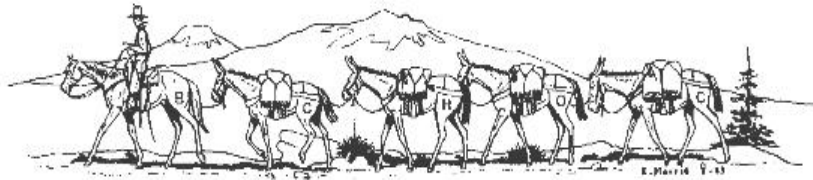

### A LITTLE INFO ABOUT OUR RIDE...

Gentle Use BCHC Trail Trial promotes: "Leave No Trace" trail riding and trail riding preparedness. The obstacles are designed to expose you and your horse to a variety of challenges. You will need to have the following items on you or your horse at the onset of the Trail Trial:

- Hoof pick • Knife • supply of water • Halter • Lead rope
- Pair of pliers or leather man tool

\*\* A first aid kit is recommended but not required. This is an extra point item.

We will be following CSHA Trail Trials rules, which are available at [www.trailtrials.com](http://www.trailtrials.com)

It is strongly recommended that Gentle use practices be reviewed on the [www.bchcalifornia.com](http://www.bchcalifornia.com) website prior to the Trail Trials, as knowledge of Gentle Use will be incorporated into the judging of obstacles. A flyer with Gentle Use practices will also be available on the day of the event.

You do not need to be a Back Country Horsemen member to participate at the trail trial.

Non-potable water is available for horses.

Overnight Primitive camping will be available for Friday night. \$8.00 per rig

Rules and Regulations Judge's decision is final. Attire—any type of clothing suitable to riding is acceptable. Appropriate riding footwear (Must have heels) is required. Helmets are required for all juniors (Under the age of 18) and recommended for all riders. No Stallions. You must be able to show proof of age upon request. No dogs allowed at this event. No Alcohol allowed while on the trail trial. Entrants must ride on a saddle and the horse must use a bridle/hackamore.

Management reserves the absolute right to refuse entry or eliminate any rider. Per California law NO smoking on the trails Lunch available by High County 4H by donations

### Directions:

**From Temecula;** I-15 to 79 South (Indio) to 371 (Anza/Indio). Go 8.4 miles to "Little Creek Ranch" on the left side of the road watch for the BCHC Signs

**From Hemet:** Highway 74 up the mountain. Turn right on 371 (Anza-San Diego) and go beyond Anza 2.5 miles past the Casino to "Little Creek Ranch" on the right side. Look for the signs.

**From Palm Desert:** Take Highway 74 up the mountain. Turn left on 371 (Anza-San Diego) and go beyond Anza 2.5 miles past the Casino to "Little Creek Ranch" on the right side. Watch for the BCHC signs.
