## EMMP Registration for CSHA Trail Trials

Several folks had questions on whether two day trail trials needed to be sanctioned with two separate EMMP numbers or not. Here is the answer from Dr. Katie Flynn who is the head of the state program and the presenter of the program at the January quarterly meeting.

**You will need two event numbers if your trail trial has a different ride manager for each day or you have a different Senior Judge for each day.**

Realizing we are sanctioning far in advance of our actual events:

1. Where your two day event is registered originally on your sanction form with one event number because you **met the criteria** listed above but that changes you must apply for another event number with EMMP and notify me to update the sanction form and website.
2. Where your two day event is registered originally on your sanction form with two event numbers because you **did not meet** the criteria listed above but that changes, you need to call the EMMP office (916-900-5002) and change the second event number to a single event number and notify me to update the sanction form and website.

Frequently Asked Questions:

I have the same ride manager for both days but different Senior Judges. Register as two events.

I have different ride managers for both days but the same Senior Judge. Register as two events.

I have the same ride manager for both days and the same Senior Judge for both days. Register as one event.

I have the same ride manager for both days and the same Senior Judge for both days but I found another Senior Judge to work on Sunday after I've registered as one event. Call the EMMP office (916) 900-5002) and explain that you need to revise your registered one day event as two events, notify the sanction chair to change your sanction form with the additional event number and the calendar of events on the website.
