Camping Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights

There are no corrals. High lining is **limited**, portable corral is **preferable**,

There is one water facet in center of camp
for human and horse consumption no hook ups.

One vault toilet and extra porta-potties. **There is a Park day use fee that is paid at the Ranger station as you enter the park.** If you don't already have a National park pass these are your **Options**, \$5.00 per day per rig, yearly pass \$25.00, or if you are 62 or older you can purchase a lifetime pass for \$10.00 good at all National parks.

The rides will be on mostly undemanding terrain, along dirt roads, single-track trails, rolling hills, some water crossings and trees. Saturday will be about a 4-hour ride, and Sunday about a 3-hour ride.

This Ride is PAC approved, and if you are a member of the APHA Ride America Program, you get double hours for your riding time as it is in a National Recreation Area, and don't forget to count your hours toward your CSHA TRAP hours.

Directions to Whiskeytown National Recreation Area Horse Camp:

Coming from the South of Redding

Take Interstate 5 To exit 678 Hwy 44 west to Eureka. Turn right on Pine follow signs to Highway 299 West to Eureka. Continue aprox 9.8 miles to Whiskeytown reservoir on Hwy 299, there will be a sign announcing the Visitors Center and Ranger's office, turn left there. If you need a pass or day pass stop there and purchase your pass. The road is paved except for about the last mile. Continue on this road past the Visitors Center, until you arrive at the Dam. Stay to the left on this road, do **not** cross the Dam. Turn left on Paige Bar Road. Continue down this road to Need camp. At the Need Camp sign (on the right) turn left and continue on this gravel road to the horse camp. There will be Trail Trials signs.

Coming from the North of Redding

Take Interstate 5 To exit 681B (Market st 273) continue to Eureka st turn right. Continue aprox 9.8 miles to Whiskeytown reservoir on Hwy 299, there will be a sign announcing the Visitors Center and Ranger's office, turn left there. If you need a pass or day pass stop there and purchase your pass. The road is paved except for about the last mile. Continue on this road past the Visitors Center, until you arrive at the Dam. Stay to the left on this road. Do **not** cross the Dam. Turn left on Paige Bar Road. Continue down this road to Need camp. At the Need Camp sign (on the right) turn left and continue on this gravel road to the horse camp. There will be Trail Trials signs.
