

Tillicum Meadows Ride
June 19, 2010

Ride is at the Tillicum Meadows (Miller Ranch)
At 12850 Cherry Lake Rd. Groveland Ca. 95321

Coming from Mariposa:

North on Hwy 49 towards Coulterville, (about 26 miles)

In Coulterville turn **Right** onto j-132 (Main Street/ Greeley Hill Road) (~7 miles)

Follow Greeley Hill Road through Greeley Hill. Approx. 1 mile past Greeley hill keep left at the fork, road name changes to Smith Station Rd.

Follow Smith Station until it dead ends into SR-120, turn **Right** (east) onto SR-120, towards Yosemite.

Follow SR-120 approximately 7 miles, (pass through **Buck Meadows**), just past the bridge turn **Left** on **Cherry Lake Rd.** (then immediate right)

Continue up Cherry Lake Rd. about 3 Miles.

The T.T. signs will be on a Tree on the Left side of the Road.

Turn **Left** off Cherry Lake Rd there. **(Please look up the road, before you turn)**

Follow the dirt road down and around the corner. Staging on the Right, camping on the left.

Coming From Oakdale:

Proceed east on SR-108/120 towards Sonora, (about 25 miles)

At Yosemite Junction SR-120 will turn **right**, follow the signs for Yosemite.

Follow SR-120 about 12.5 miles, you will go up New Priest Grade. Through Big Oak Flat and Groveland

Continue on SR-120 past Groveland, about 10 miles.

Pass through Buck Meadows. Approximately 4 miles past Buck Meadows you will cross a bridge, just past the bridge turn **Left** on Cherry Lake Rd. (then immediate right)

Continue up Cherry Lake Rd. about 3 Miles. The T.T. signs will be on a Tree on the Left side of the Road.

Turn **Left** off Cherry Lake Rd there. **(Please look up the road, before you turn)**

Follow the dirt road down and around the corner. Staging on the Right, camping on the Left.

Sonora

Head toward Yosemite on Highway 120 through Groveland and follow the Oakdale instructions.

Terrain will be on the rolling hillsides, no real steep hills, there are rocks, water crossings, logs, animals and trees. Horses need shoes.

For camping, there are no paddocks, hot fences and portable fences are good. You need water buckets, water is available.

There will be a **Breakfast**, and **Lunch**, we will be accepting donations.

Breakfast will be biscuits and gravy, and an egg dish. Coffee.

Lunch will be Tri Tip, salad, beans, and bread.
