Deep in a valley framed by oak-covered hills, Del Valle is a lakeside resort just 10 miles south of Livermore. With a five-mile-long lake featuring water-oriented recreation, Del Valle is surrounded by about 5,000 acres of beautiful trails for horseback riding and hiking. As the eastern gateway to the Ohlone Wilderness Trail, Del Valle features 28 miles of scenic back country trail.

Please join Region 5 for two separate Trail Trial events at Lake Del Valle. You may camp from Thursday, June 1st at noon through Monday June 5th at noon or drive each day. Check-in begins Friday afternoon at 4 pm and will continue on Saturday and Sunday at 8:30 am. There will be no rider's meeting; instead you will receive written instructions when you check in. The first rider & horse teams will ride out each day at 9:00 am. Please select your ride time and we will do our best to schedule accordingly. Please verify your actual ride time when you check-in. You will have the same start-time for both Saturday and Sunday. **Awards will be given through 6th place for each category/age group each day.**

We are limiting the ride to 50 competitors, so get your entries in early!! Check the California Trail Trials Facebook page for updates on available space, or call Ellen at 510-506-2600.

Camping will be available at the *Caballo Loco* group horse camp. Camping fees of \$12/night are payable at the Del Valle Entry Gate by identifying yourself as a Trail Trial participant. There is an additional charge for dogs of \$2 per dog per night. **We have ten pens available by reservation first come/first based upon receipt of your entry with pen fees included.** You may set up horse pens or tie to your trailer. There are very few trees for high lining. Horse water-troughs and a few water spigots are available. We welcome water hoses that we can all share. There is a dump area for manure, so bring your own wheel barrows and forks. For safety, all dogs must remain tied or on leash and under control at all times. Without exception, the owner of any loose dog will be asked to contain the dog in their trailer for the remainder of the weekend.

Friday night: Fun campfire at the Caballo Logo group fire pit. We will offer an optional Trail Trial Q&A session and help with tying the bowline knot. Please bring a short length of rope. **Saturday night Pot-Luck barbecue** at 6:30 PM. We provide barbecued tri- tip, lemonade, water, cutlery and paper products. Bring your favorite dish to contribute to the rest of the potluck meal. The cost will be \$5 for adults and \$3 for children **Park Rules:** No hard alcoholic beverages. No smoking on the trails or in the grassy areas. **Directions:**

Del Valle Regional Park is located on Del Valle Road off Mines Road south of Livermore. Exit I-580 eastbound or westbound in Livermore at North Livermore Avenue. Head south and proceed through town (North Livermore Avenue will become South Livermore Avenue in town). About 1.5 miles outside town, turn right at Mines Road, go about 3.5 miles and continue straight on Del Valle Road (Mines Road turns left). The park entrance is about four miles ahead. Once you are in the park, turn left at the park entry kiosk, go about a half mile and turn left to find Caballo Loco Horse Camp. If you cross the bridge, you have gone too far. *Watch for the Trail Trial signs!*

I acknowledge that horseback riding is a sport that carries inherent risks of injury and damage to myself, my horse and property. I knowingly assume all risks, whether known or unknown, of horseback riding.

I hereby release the California State Horsemen's Association (hereinafter referred to as CSHA) and the East Bay Regional Parks District (hereinafter referred to as The Park) from all liability for any act of negligence or want of ordinary care on the part of CSHA and/or The Park, or any of its agents. In consideration of my participation in events organized or sponsored by CSHA, I wave, release and discharge CSHA and The Park, their directors, officers, agents and members, their representatives, heirs, executors and assigns from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals or my property arising out of my participation. This agreement is binding upon my executors, heirs and assigns.

I expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil Code 1542, which states: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him might have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."

I agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless CSHA and The Park, their directors, officers, agents and members, against all claims, demands, and causes of action, including court costs and actual attorney fees, arising from any proceeding or lawsuits brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this release is upheld.

CSHA, its agents or employees shall not be liable for any damage, which may accrue from any cause or as a result of fire, theft, running away, state of health, injury to person, horse or property.
