Round Valley Regional Preserve consists of 1,911 acres of grassland and oak woodland which occur along rolling hills and northeastern facing slopes. On the ride you will travel along single track trail incorporating moderate up and down slope paths and fire road along Round Valley Creek. Horses should be in good condition and the ride will test the trail experience of the rider, horse, and the horse-rider combination. Distance is approximately 5 miles ~ 3-4 hrs.

Companion Rider/Schooling \$10

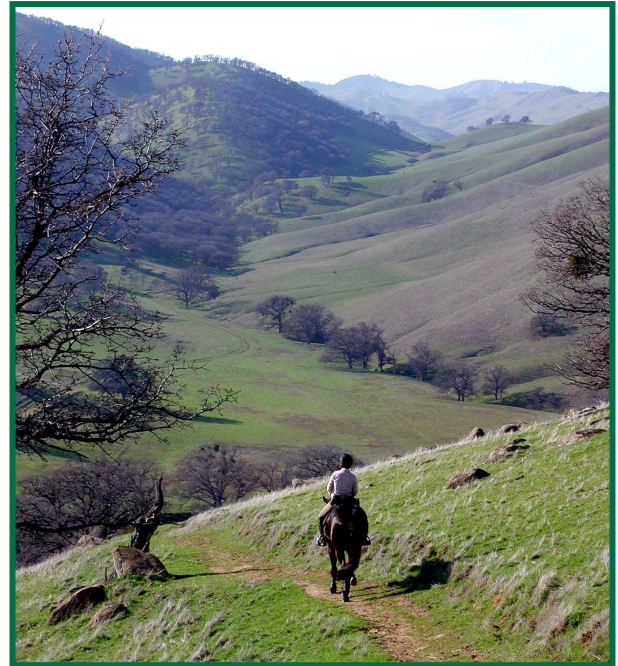
Late Fee (after June 6) \$ 5
