In consideration of my participation in events organized or sponsored by CSHA-Reg. 5, I wave, release and discard CSHA Reg. 5 and CMDTRA and Mt. Diablo State Park., their directors, officers, agents and members, their representatives heirs, executors and assigns from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals or my property arising out of my participation. This agreement is binding upon my executors, heirs and assigns.

I expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil Code 1 542, which state, " A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him might have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.

I agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless CSHA Reg. 5, CMDTRA and Mt. Diablo State Park, their officers, directors, members and agents against all claims, demands, and causes of action including court costs and actual attorney fees arising from any proceeding or lawsuits brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this release is upheld. CSHA-reg. 5, CMDTRA and Mt. Diablo State Park its agents or employees shall not be liable for any damage which may accrue from any cause or as a result of fire, theft, running away, state of health, injury to person, horse or property.

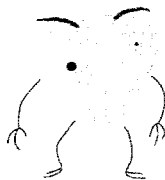

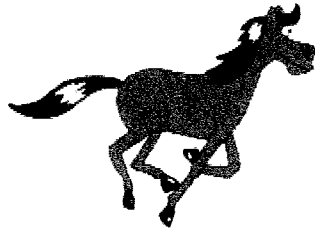


EVERYONE IS WELCOME TO COMPETE FOR DAY AWARDS
but if you are interested in competing for year-end high point awards(a combination of three or more rides) and to participate in the Show of Champions event in Lake Oroville in October you must be a CSHA member and a member of the TRAIL TRIALS program. New members and renewals are welcome and easy to do. You may sign up the morning of the competition. Bring an extra check!

Members: remember to sign the RAP sheet!!!!!!

TERRAIN AND DISTANCE: Beautiful riding on rolling foothills and canton trails, approximately five miles, some steep and rocky. Horses should be shod. You are responsible for your horse.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: Saddle, bridle, a halter with lead rope or halter bridle, and a hoof pick must be carried on this ride. In addition, adults must carry a pocket knife. Helmets are required for juniors and recommended for adults.



DIRECTIONS: From South or West take the Ygnacio Valley exit off 680, go 7 miles to Clayton Rd. Take a right onto Clayton Road it will turn into Marsh Creek Rd., just past the Pumpkin Farm take a right onto Russelmann Rd. and follow the signs to the Clubhouse.

From the North, take Treat Blvd exit. Follow Treat east to Clayton Rd and then follow the above directions from Clayton Rd.
