This is not a timed event. The trail is approximately 5 miles in length with 8-10 natural obstacles. Judging occurs only on the obstacles. Riders 17 and under must be accompanied by an adult rider and wear a approved helmet throughout the ride. Camping is available for \$15 per night.

Check in starting at 7:30 a.m., First rider out at 8:30.

Early-entries get preferred ride out times first!

Ride fee is \$40 (Includes \$5 parking fee, \$5 drug fee & \$3 CSHA state fees)
