RE: 2020 Trail Trails Season

I have been communicating with Region Chairs in the last few months, and all have been struggling to keep out season alive.

Health Administrators in Calaveras, Tuolumne, Placer, Butte and El Dorado Counties have all told me the same thing. At this time, they have opened up somewhat to their local residents, but do not want more than 10 people from the same family group camping or gatherings until the Governor moves into Phase 3 or 4 of the Stay at Home Order. In addition, Jim Hendrickson sent out a notice that if we did not have county approval to hold our event, then our insurance carrier would not cover ride managers or the facility.

I have also spoken to the facilities manager at 3-Links Camp; the facility with whom we contracted our SCE 2020 event and he indicated that they will most likely not even open the camp this year. 3-Links is also in Tuolumne County.

I have spoken to R1 President Claudia Stevens and R1 TT Chair Stephanie Davis will cancel the Napa Ride. R2 President Charlotte Johnson and Sue Kellogg R2 TT Chair and they will be canceling the Meadowbrook ride. R3 President and Dru Banner Ride Manager Dana Peterson will be canceling their ride. R5 TT Chairman Rene Spore Turnbull will not hold the ride in Napa in conjunction with R1 as planned.

In light of the current Stay at Home Orders from the State and Counties in California, the majority of our rides have been cancelled and as much as I hate to say it, we are going to have to cancel the rest of our 2020 Trail Trials Season which includes not having a SCE Event this year.

If things open up and Counties start to allow camping, we could still organize a few rides and camping events. SCE Benefit, Kerrick Coral are later in the year and I will stay in contact with the Health Administrators in those counties. I encourage all ride managers to contact your local Health Administrators as things begin to change, and if there is an opportunity to hold an event, coordinate with your Region Presidents to see how we can make something happen.

Thank you for all you do and let me know how I can continue to help.
