Please join CSHA Region 2 and 3 for two days in the beautiful rolling hills of Spenceville Wildlife Area, celebrating spring and your chance to get out there and ride. Lots of fun obstacles, beautiful scenery, and great people to ride with.

- **Terrain:** Spenceville Wildlife area is 11,000 acres of beautiful rolling hills with easy to moderate terrain and great views. Saturday's ride is the longer trail with about 4+ miles and 10 obstacles. Sunday's ride is a shorter ride about 3-4 miles with 8 obstacles.
- **Camping** \$20.00 per night/per rig. You must haul in your own water. There are no pens available. Camping will be in a beautiful open field.
- **Awards:** Ribbons given through 6th place. Awards through third place.
- **Raffle prizes** will be announced on Sunday after the ride.
- **Directions** The Spenceville Wildlife Area is north of Lincoln, north of Camp Far West Lake, east of Marysville. It is off Chuck Yeager Road just south of the Waldo Road intersection. **From Sacramento**, to Marysville take highway 20 towards Grass Valley. Once you get to Smartsville look for Fire Station and Blue Storage units Turn right. Go about 1.5 miles to Chuck Yeager. Take a Left on Chuck Yeager Road just south of Waldo Road intersection. About 300 feet.

Alternative Spenceville directions:

This is a short cut from going all the way north to Hwy 20 but does several jogs with a couple stop signs. It avoids the washboard gravel road out of Wheatland.

From I-80 or other points south of Marysville, take Hwy 65 north to where it joins Hwy 70 (Olivehurst). take Erle Road (exit 18B) off to right (east) at STOP sign turn left then right on Erle Road go 1.7 mi. to Griffith Ave., turn left (north) go 1.6 mi to Hammonton/Smartsville Road turn Right (east) go approx 13.2 miles and turn Right on to Chuck Yeager Road (there will be a sign & ribbons) go approx 4.5 miles just past Waldo Road and turn right into camp. We'll have signs and ribbons.

If you are coming from south/west of Sacramento take I 5, merge onto Hwy 99-70 north to Olivehurst. Take Erle Road (exit 18B) off to right (east) at STOP sign turn left then right on Erle Road go 1.7 mi. to Griffith Ave., turn left (north) go 1.6 mi to Hammonton/Smartsville Road turn Right (east) go approx 13.2 miles and turn Right on to Chuck Yeager Road (there will be a sign & ribbons) go approx 4.5 miles just past Waldo Road and turn right into camp. We'll have signs and ribbons.

If coming from Nevada or east of Emigrant Gap, take the Hwy 20 off ramp and stay on 20 west through Nevada City and Grass Valley towards Marysville. .

Once you get to Smartsville look for Fire Station and Blue Storage units. Turn left onto Hammonton-Smartsville Road. Go about 1.5 miles to Chuck Yeager Road. Take a Left on Chuck Yeager Road, go about 4.5 miles. Brushy Creek is just south of Waldo Road intersection. About 300 feet.
