To reserve a horse pen, a cabin or lodge room, please call Greenhorn directly (530 – 283–0930), otherwise fill out the entry form which includes prices for camping with us in the big meadow. Don't forget to bring your portable corals! No high tying area.

JUNIOR RIDERS 17 and under must wear an approved helmet and a responsible adult must accompany them whenever they are with their equine.

TERRAIN is moderate to semi rugged sierra trail with creek crossings, single track trail, good uphill/downhills and forested mountains. Elevation is approximately 4,000 feet. Equines should be shod, booted or conditioned for such terrain.

Saturday's ride will be approximately 7 miles with 10-12 obstacles.

Sunday's ride will be approximately 5 miles with 8-10 obstacles.

You are only judged at the obstacles after the judge or reader tells you you may proceed. Please use good trail etiquette and be aware that there are novice riders and green horses out there.

Smoking only allowed in your own trailer/rig. Dogs must be on leash at all times and not allowed on trails. Due to extreme fire hazards in August, no campfires.

GETTING THERE

From Sacramento: take Hwy 99/70 north towards Marysville, stay on Hwy 70 north which turns into Hwy 70/the Feather River Highway/Hwy 89 towards Quincy CA. You will drive through the town of Quincy (lots of shopping/fuel), approximately 12 miles after the Safeway grocery store, turn left on Greenhorn Ranch Rd. There are a couple other routes that get you there just fine. Find your favorite route on a map or map app...it's pretty straight forward but not a straight road ☺

COVID rules: Must social distance, wear a mask when not socially distant outside, and inside at all times. Wash hands frequently. No mask required when working with or on an equine.
